Populace Meeting

August 11th, 2013

On Sunday, August 11, 2013 The Barony of SunDragon will be holding its monthly court night from 6 PM to 10 PM. There will be no fighting tournaments at this event. All are encouraged to bring clothing and toys for a wet and wild water party.

Most importantly, the Barony will be holding a populace meeting to discuss and determine several different topics. For those who cannot make the meeting, we are listing the subjects and details below. Please feel free to email your opinions to the Baroness and Baron and The Baronial Seneschal.

1. Fighter practice location

Baronial fighter practice is the single biggest expense the Barony has. We pay \$20 every Sunday that the park is used and \$10 per hour that the lights are used during the summer hours. Being a completely fenced in private park also limits the public exposure, participation, and potential recruitment of newcomers. The question being put forward to the Baronial family is do we wish to explore the possibility of moving the practice location to a place with more public access if one could be found with lower (or no costs) to use.

- A. Yes we should explore the possibility.
- B. No we should stay where we are at.

2. Kon Hawk memorial fund

The populace must be polled before any changes can be made to the Charter per its' own rules. What is being proposed is that the Charter be rewritten to allow for multiple methods to raise money for the fund: tournaments named after members of the Barony who have passed away, A&S fundraisers and auctions, games and raffles, etc. All money raised would still go to the Kon Hawk memorial fund and all methods for requesting and dispersing those funds would remain untouched. This change would allow for funds to be raised (such as the Rainbow Bridge event) throughout the year.

For the Barony of SunDragon, we will be holding several competitions between now and Estrella 30 to determine who will represent the Barony. These will take place on:

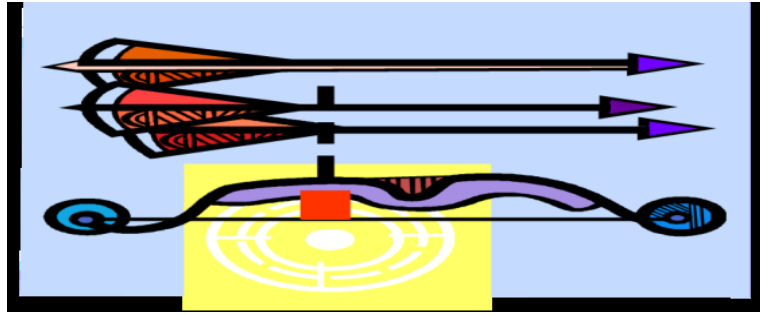
- *Sunday, September 15 at

Fighter Practice is held at Cheyenne Park on Sundays.

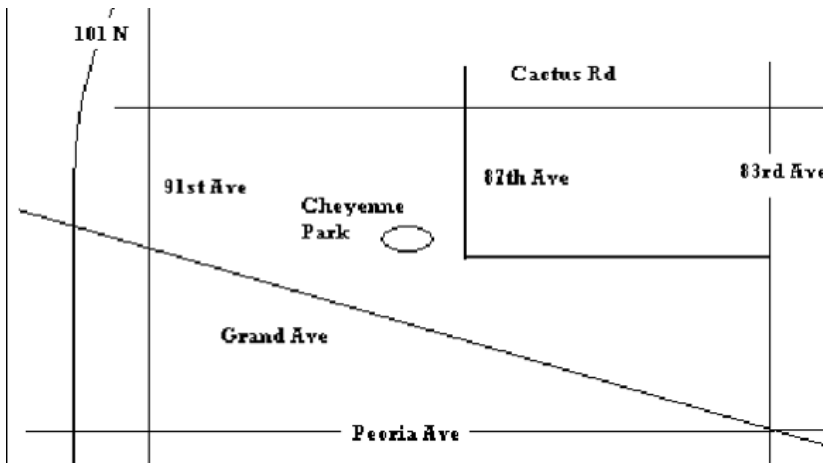
From May to October the time is 6 PM to 10 PM
