Fighter Practice is held at Cheyenne Park on Sundays.

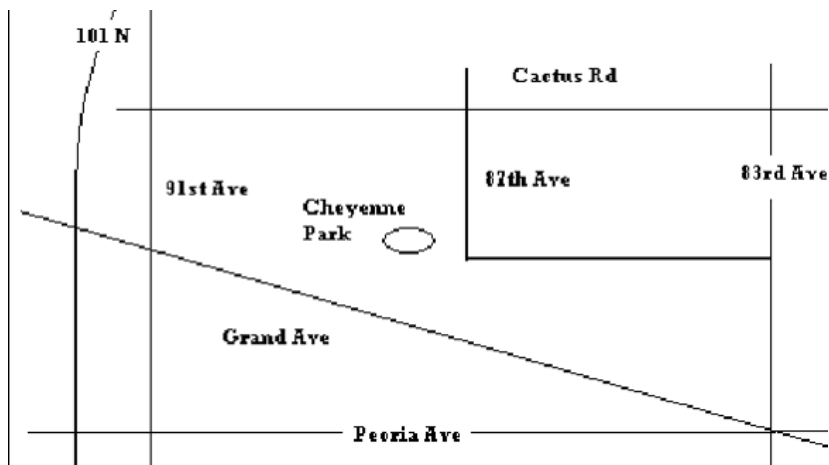
From May to October the time is 6 PM to 10 PM
